WHAT

National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day 77th Anniversary Commemoration Ceremony

The National Park Service and the United States Navy will host the National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day 77th Anniversary Commemoration Ceremony to honor and remember the 2,390 Americans killed during the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor and on the island of Oahu on December 7, 1941.

The ceremony will begin at 7:50 a.m. and take place on the Ceremonial Lawn at the Pearl Harbor Visitor Center. Pearl Harbor Survivors, WWII veterans, family members, and local dignitaries will be in attendance. Admiral Philip S. Davidson, Commander, U.S. Indo-Pacific Command, will deliver the keynote.
